

AUTHORSHIP AMENDMENT NOTICE

Evidence has been brought to the attention of the editorial board of the **Journal of Physiotherapy Research** (ISSN 2238-2704) that the authorship of the paper "*Pilot study on lumbar canal diameter and walking distance in patients with lumbar spinal stenosis: a multivariate prediction model*", published in the 2022 issue of the journal, under DOI 10.17267/2238-2704rpf.2022.e4827, was incomplete. One of its authors, which had not been disclaimed during the submission nor the peer review stages, was missing.

Considering that (1) the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors defines scientific authorship as substantial intellectual contributions to the conception and study design and/or interpretation of results, (2) the Hong Kong Principles state that research supervision and mentorship should be acknowledged as important to the advancement of the scientific enterprise and (3) the Committee of Publication Ethics strictly recommends to give credit to authors who did significantly participate in the development of a research and/or research report, after consulting with all authors involved in the aforementioned report, in common agreement, they have decided to amend the authorship as published in this erratum.

Author contributions to the present research report have also been amended.
